I absolutely love the work environment and everyone here. It's always fun coming to work.

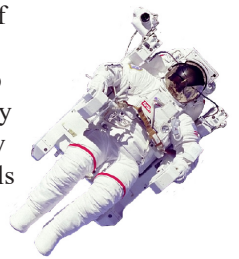
Where do you see yourself in the next 5 years? No longer working as an Assistant PM and obtaining more dogs.

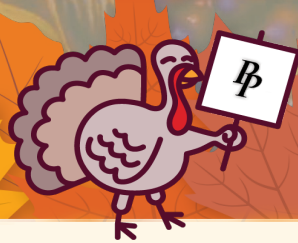

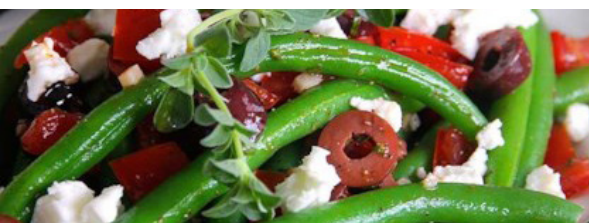

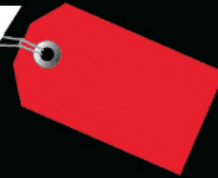

TIPS

The most important way to ensure that you're taking advantage of Black Friday is to plan ahead. Make sure that you work out a specific budget. Avoid overspending on frivolous items that seem heavily discounted. No matter how good the deal is, it's not saving money if it's something you don't need.

- Make a list of people you need to purchase gifts for and then search for the best deals online ahead of time.

The Tour de Cure is a series of fundraising, cycling and 5k run/walk events held in 44 states nationwide to benefit the American Diabetes Association. Nearly 1 in 2 American adults has diabetes or prediabetes: 84 million adults have prediabetes and 90% of them are not aware of their risk for diabetes. The ADA strives to increase the number of screenings, increase awareness, and increase action.

Are you **at risk for type 2 diabetes?**

Consider taking the ADA's Risk Test if you:

Are 45 years or older

Are an overweight adult of any age, and

- Have a parent, brother or sister with type 2 diabetes
- Are physically inactive
- Have ever had gestational diabetes (diabetes during pregnancy)
- Have high blood pressure
- Have a history of cardiovascular disease
- There are other risk factors. Talk to your doctor if you have concerns.

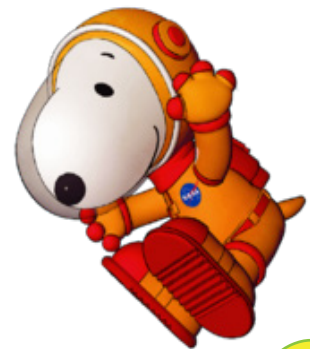

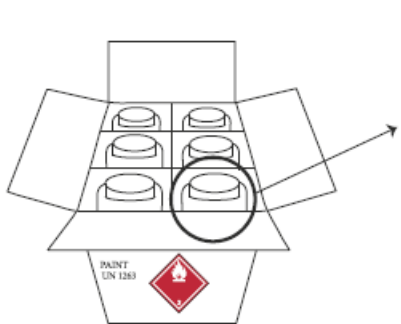

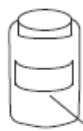

Globally Harmonized System of Classification and labeling of Chemicals (GHS) (may be found on means of containment during transport)

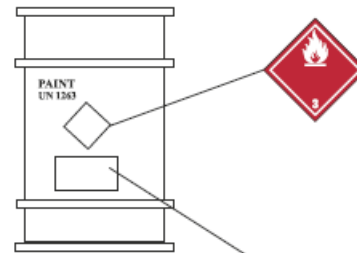
Examples of GHS labeling:

with flammable liquid
transport label

bottle with GHS hazard
warning label



Single Packaging: 200 L
(55 US gallons) drum with
a flammable liquid transport
label combined with GHS

PIPELINES MARKERS

Since pipelines are usually buried underground, pipeline markers are used to indicate their presence in an area along the pipeline route. Of the three types of pipelines typically buried underground — distribution, gathering, and transmission — only transmission pipelines are marked with the following above-ground markers used to indicate their route. Markers warn that a transmission pipeline is located in the area, identify the product transported in the line, and provide the name and telephone number of the pipeline operator to call.
